PPE

- Red/Amber site stock issues should be highlighted via the daily workforce return to ensure appropriate prioritisation

Caring for People at Highest Clinical Risk During COVID-19

Further to our message in the MPU on Thursday 9 April – further guidance and support is now available to GPs.

We know national deadlines have been set against the various tasks and acknowledge that these are unachievable. We need to balance the urgency and importance of this work against the need to get the lists right and identify the correct cohort of patients. The greatest importance is the task itself and that it is being done properly rather than rushing to complete it by a specific date.
